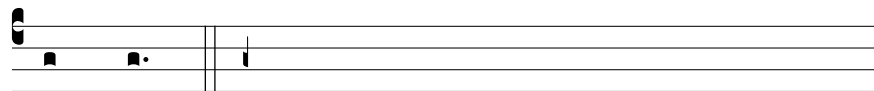
4. Sing praise to the LORD with the harp,
