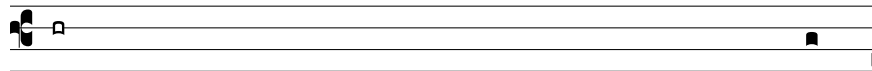




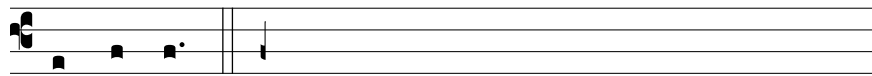
3. See, the eyes of the LORD are upon those who fear
