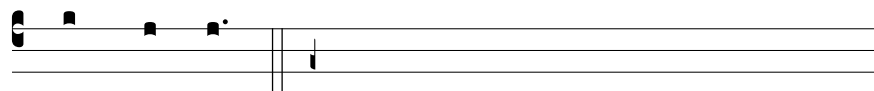
1. Come, let us sing joyfully to the LORD; let us



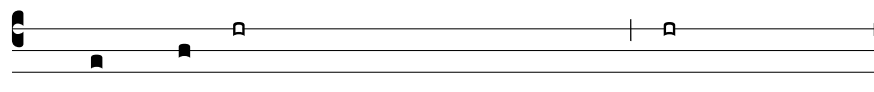
acclaim the Rock of our sal-*va*-tion. Let us come into



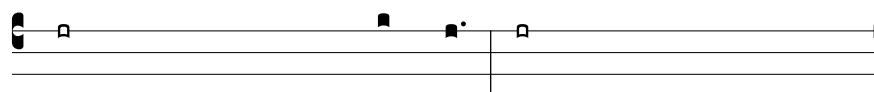
his presence with thanksgiving; let us joyful-*ly* sing



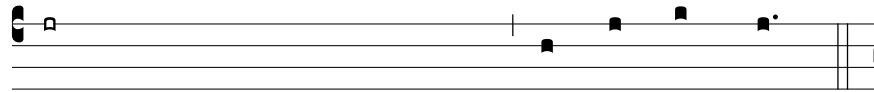
psalms to him. R̄.



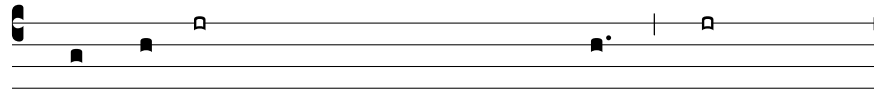
2. Come, let us bow down in worship; let us kneel



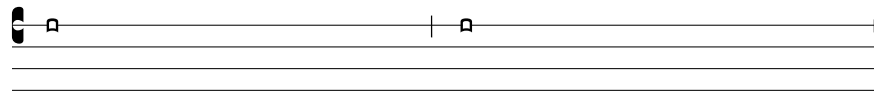
before the LORD who *made* us. For he is our God, and



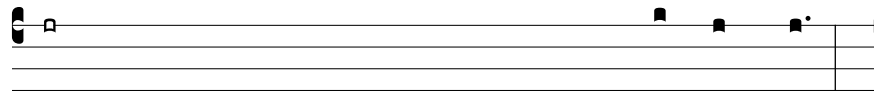
we are the people he shepherds, *the* flock he guides. Ṙ.



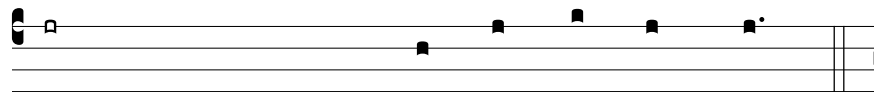
3. Oh, that today you would hear his *voice*: "Harden not
