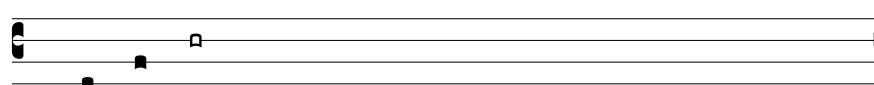

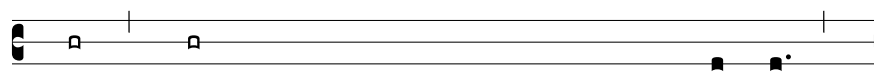

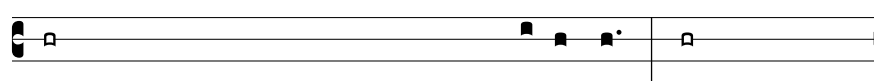

1. Blessed the man who follows not the counsel of the



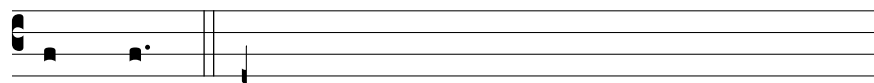
wicked, nor walks in the way of *sin*-ners,



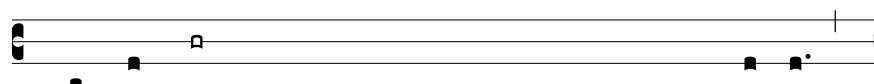
nor sits in the company of the *in*-solent, but delights



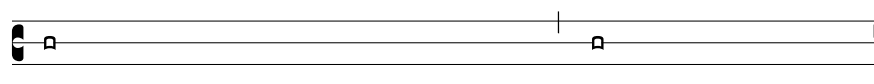
in the law of the LORD and meditates on *his* law day



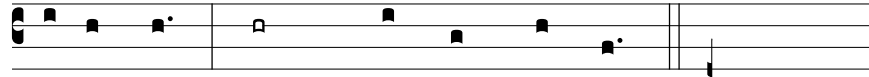

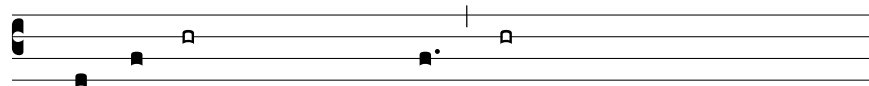
2. He is like a tree planted near running *wa*-ter,



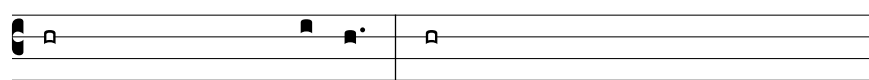
that yields its fruit in due season, and whose leaves



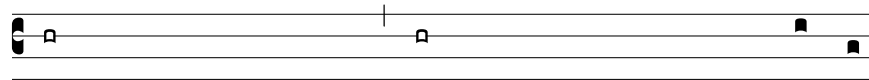
nev-er fade. Whatever *he* does, prospers. Ṙ.



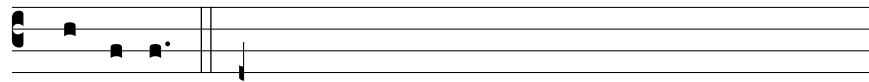
3. Not so the wicked, not *so*; they are like chaff which
